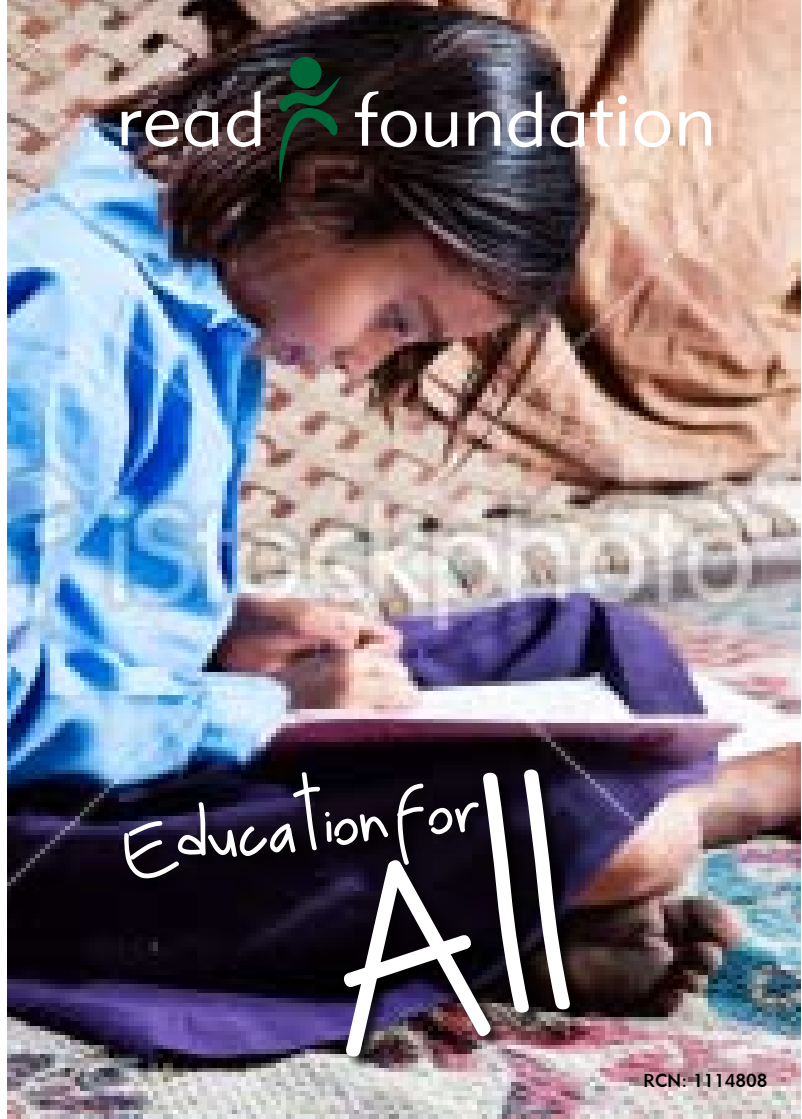

# Clean Drinking

Water

**T**he biggest cause of disease and death in poor communities is drinking dirty water. Over the last few years, READ Foundation has been installing safe water wells into schools in order to maintain the health of the children. This Sadaqah Jaaria project ensures children stay healthy, perform well and are not worried about some of the basics that we take for granted.

For only **£650** you can install a deep water well in a school, providing water for, on average, 210 children every day. **We will send you details of the well you install and can affix a plaque with your name or that of a loved ones.**

# Educating Orphans

**S**ince 1994, READ Foundation has been supporting Orphans through our ‘educate a child’ scheme. **For only £10 per month** (less than the cost of a bag of crisps each day), these vulnerable and innocent children are given the tools to change their futures.

We need your support to continue and grow this work.

**For only £10 a month**, you can help educate a needy orphan out of poverty and enable him/her to stand on their own two feet.

**Your £10 per month (or annual payment of only £120) will ensure that over the course of a year an orphan is provided with:**

- School Fees
- Books
- Stationery
- Uniform
- School Bag
- Shoes

Upon receipt of your sponsorship, we will send you a complete profile of the child. This includes personal, family and academic information along with a recent photograph.

# Educating Communities

## School Building Programme:

Amongst one of the biggest issues in the provision of education to poor communities is the lack of good quality accommodation for the schools. Imagine a 'classroom' where children are forced to sit on a dirty floor, roofs are leaking and the stench of the sewers overpowering. This is a familiar occurrence in many locations as the premises being used is a shed, barn or an old home never designed for such purposes. Our 'build a school' programme is designed to address this very issue. Costs of schools can vary from place to place, but for **£50,000** a full primary school can be constructed.

Please donate generously to our 'build a school' fund or if you have the means, why not commit to raising the funds for a complete construction. The school will be constructed in your name and you can even visit it and maintain a long term relationship with the teachers and students there.

## Adopt a School Programme:

Many locations already have a suitable building but roofs are leaking, furniture broken and repairs overdue. Our 'adopt a school' programme works to upgrade existing schools, provide equipment for classrooms and labs, supply new furniture, computers, sports kits and teaching aids. For only **£7,500** you can 'adopt' a school following which a full report with details will be sent to you. You can even spread the cost of the adoption out over **12 months @ £625** per month. Alternatively, please donate any amount you like to our 'Adopt a school' fund.

## Classroom Sponsorship:

As we only work in needy rural locations and with an average of **25 children per class**, our **adopt a classroom scheme** allows you to sponsor the education of all the needy children in the class. For **£250 per month**, you will be supplying fees, books, stationary, uniforms, bags and shoes for a whole generation of similar aged children. This support will ease the pressure on the school and more importantly allow children and parents to feel confident in their ability to sustain their child through their education.
